APPROVING AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT WITH TRITECH SOFTWARE SYSTEMS FOR STREET MAINTENANCE SOFTWARE AND HOSTING SERVICES

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2019, by Roll Call No. 19-1622, the City Council approved an agreement with Lucity, Inc to provide software solutions for the Public Works Department for street maintenance management (Lucity Agreement); and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department now desires to replace 35 seat modules with 10 mobile management modules, at a cost savings to the City of \$9,958; and

WHEREAS, the assets of Lucity, Inc. have been purchased by TriTech Software Systems (TriTech) and TriTech desires to obtain the City's consent to assignment of such Lucity Agreement to TriTech; and

WHEREAS, TriTech agrees to be bound by all terms of the Lucity Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Public Works Department staff have negotiated an Amendment to the Lucity agreement for the purchase of 10 mobile modules and consent to the assignment of the Lucity Agreement to TriTech, a copy of which is on file in the City clerk's Office; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the Amendment described above is hereby approved and the Public Works Director is authorized and directed to execute said Amendment, a copy of which is on file in the City Clerk's Office, and the City Clerk is authorized to attest to his signature.
