RESOLUTION APPROVING TEMPORARY AMENDMENT TO NEIGHBORHOOD RECOGNITION POLICY

WHEREAS, on May 24, 1993, by Roll Call No. 93-2026, the City Council approved the Neighborhood Recognition Policy (the "Policy") which establishes procedures for the formal recognition of neighborhood associations by the City of Des Moines, and authorizes Recognized neighborhoods to advise the City on issues of concern; and

WHEREAS, the Neighborhood Revitalization Board (NRB) and City staff reviewed the Policy with regards to requirements for Board Officers or Positions to live within the City of Des Moines or own a property or business in Des Moines; and

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2021, the Neighborhood Recognition Board approved an amendment to the Neighborhood Recognition Policy and forward such recommendation to the City Council, which amendment is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:

- 1. That the amendment to the Neighborhood Recognition Policy, as attached hereto, are hereby approved, and the Neighborhood Revitalization Board and City staff are directed and authorized to administer said Policy in accordance with said amendments. (Council Communication No. 21-205)
