WHEREAS, the Information Technology (IT) Department has requested the Finance Department's Procurement Division issue a purchase order for Cisco Catalyst 9300 and Catalyst 9500 network hardware from Heartland Business Systems in the amount of \$215,196.62; and

WHEREAS, the Cisco Catalyst 9300 and Catalyst 9500 network hardware from Heartland Business Systems (Peter Helander, CEO, 108 3rd Street, Suite 300, Des Moines, Iowa, 50309) is being purchased per the State of Iowa Contract No. 4846A, NASPO ValuePoint AR233, which is competitively bid; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726 (k) provides for the procurement of goods and/or services from contracts established by the State of Iowa Department of Administrative Services, the Iowa Department of Transportation, or the Iowa Communications Network pursuant to procedures established by Iowa Code Chapter 8A and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, without conforming to the competitive bidding requirements of the Procurement Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, funding is available in CIP FY2021/22, MS001, C051IT99, Enhanced Information and Communication Systems, Page 33.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, accepts and approves the purchase of Cisco Catalyst 9300 and Catalyst 9500 network hardware from Heartland Business Systems, LLC in the total amount of \$215,196.62 using pricing under the State of Iowa Contract No. 4846A, NASPO ValuePoint AR233.
