BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That the contract and bond, in the amount of \$427,660.75, executed by Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Timothy Mallicoat, President, 5550 NE 22nd Street, Des Moines, IA, 50313 dated December 6, 2021, for the construction of the following improvement:

The improvement includes scarification, furnish and place Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement, pavement removal, traffic control, seeding, and other incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 635-001/034 located on Evergreen Avenue from Marion Street to S.E. 30th Court in Des Moines, Iowa

the same to be performed in accordance with the plans and specifications which have been heretofore approved by this Council, be and the same are hereby approved, subject to receipt of the contract and bond approved as to form by the Legal Department, and certificate of insurance acceptable to the Engineering Departments. The attached "Contractor's Anticipated DBE/TSB Utilization" shows the Contractor's efforts to solicit DBE/TSB Participation in accordance with the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise/Targeted Small Business (DBE/TSB) Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract on behalf of the City of Des Moines, subject to receipt of the contract and bond approved as to form by the Legal Department, and certificate of insurance acceptable to the Engineering Department, and the City Clerk, be and is hereby authorized and directed to attest to same. No contract shall be deemed to exist between the City of Des Moines and said Bidder until said contract has been executed by the Bidder, and shall have been approved by this Council and executed by the Mayor and attested to by the City Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That after said contract has been executed by the Mayor, the City Clerk be and is hereby authorized and directed to return the Contractor's bid security in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the attached Permission to Sublet form, from said Contractor requesting permission to sublet designated items, be and is hereby approved, subject to receipt of the contract and bond approved as to form by the Legal Department, and certificate of insurance acceptable to the Engineering Department; and each subcontractor is hereby granted permission to work on said improvement.



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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to encumber this contract amount against the funds as identified below, and to acquire Builder's Risk Insurance, if appropriate, for the above referenced improvement.

## **CONTRACT**

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into at Des Moines, Iowa, on <u>December 6, 2021</u>, by and between the City of Des Moines, by its Mayor, upon order of its City Council, hereinafter called the "Jurisdiction", and <u>Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation</u>, hereinafter called the "Contractor".

## WITNESSETH:

The Contractor hereby agrees to complete the work comprising the below referenced improvement as specified in the contract documents, which are officially on file with the Jurisdiction, in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office. This contract includes all contract documents. The work under this contract shall be constructed in accordance with the SUDAS Standard Specifications, 2021 Edition; and as further modified by the supplemental specifications and special provisions included in said contract documents, and the Contract Attachments attached hereto. The Des Moines City Engineer is the Engineer. The Contractor further agrees to complete the work in strict accordance with said contract documents, and to guarantee the work as required by law, for the time required in said contract documents, after its acceptance by the Jurisdiction.

This contract is awarded and executed for completion of the work specified in the contract documents for the bid prices shown on the Contract Attachment: Item 2: Bid Items, Quantities and Prices which were proposed by the Contractor in its proposal submitted in accordance with the Notice to Bidders for the following described improvements:

The improvement includes scarification, furnish and place Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement, pavement removal, traffic control, seeding, and other incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 635-001/034 located on Evergreen Avenue from Marion Street to S.E. 30th Court in Des Moines, Iowa

The Contractor agrees to perform said work for and in consideration of the Jurisdiction's payment of the bid amount of Four Hundred Twenty Seven Thousand Six Hundred Sixty and 75/100 dollars (\$427,660.75) which amount shall constitute the required amount of the performance, payment, and maintenance bond. - 1. The Contractor acknowledges and agrees:

The City of Des Moines assumes that the Contractor will maintain a safe worksite; however, City of Des Moines staff will not intrude in the Contractor's responsibility for safety issues.
  - That until the work is accepted by the Jurisdiction; the work shall be in the custody of and under the charge, care, and control of the Contractor.
  - That the Contractor is responsible for the project area or work site.
  - That the Contractor is solely responsible for the safety of everyone on its work site.
  - That it is the Contractor's sole responsibility to provide as safe a working site as possible given the nature of the work.
  - That it is the Contractor's responsibility to notify and advise its employees, subcontractors, suppliers, and everyone on the worksite of the dangers associated with the work, and provide them with appropriate safety information to protect them from those dangers.
- 5. The Contractor acknowledges and agrees that no contract shall be binding upon the City of Des Moines until said contract has been executed by the Bidder, and shall have been approved by the City Council and executed by the Mayor and attested to by the City Clerk.

## CONTRACT ATTACHMENT: ITEM 3 - COMPLETION PROVISIONS

The Contractor hereby agrees to:

- 1. Commence the work on or before a date to be specified in a written Notice to Proceed by the City and to fully complete all work no later than September 15, 2022; and to pay liquidated damages for noncompliance with said completion provision in the amount of one thousand and no/100 dollars (\$1,000.00) for each calendar day thereafter.
- 2. Undertake and schedule work in compliance with Working Day completion provisions as described below.

**Working Day Completion Provision #1:** 

The Contractor shall fully complete all work included in this project, within fifteen (15) working days of beginning work on this project; noncompliance with said fifteen (15) working days shall result in payment of liquidated damages with said completion provisions in the amount of one thousand and no/100 dollars (\$1,000.00) for each working day thereafter.

Working Day Completion Provision #2:

Contractor shall have access to no individual driveway or side road closed for more than seven (7) working days. Noncompliance with said seven (7) working day requirement shall result in payment of liquidated damages with said completion provisions in the amount of one thousand and no/100 dollars (\$1,000.00) for each working day thereafter.

3. Pay separate sums of liquidated damages that will be assessed for each of the conditions described hereinbefore, and they shall be cumulative if multiple conditions have not been satisfied.

## PERFORMANCE, PAYMENT & MAINTENANCE BOND

## KNOW ALL BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, as Principal (the "Contractor" or "Principal"), and Western Surety Company, as Surety, are held and firmly bound unto the City of Des Moines, as Obligee (the "Jurisdiction"), and to all persons who may be injured by any breach of any of the conditions of this Bond in the penal sum of Four Hundred Twenty Seven Thousand Six Hundred Sixty and 75/100 dollars (\$427,660.75), lawful money of the United States, for the payment of which sum, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, legal representatives and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

The conditions of the above obligations are such that whereas the Contractor entered into a contract with the Jurisdiction, bearing the date of <u>December 6, 2021</u>, (the "Contract") wherein the Contractor undertakes and agrees to construct the following described improvements:

Evergreen Avenue Rehabilitation from Marion Street to S.E. 30th Court, 062019021

The improvement includes scarification, furnish and place Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement, pavement removal, traffic control, seeding, and other incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 635-001/034 located on Evergreen Avenue from Marion Street to S.E. 30th Court in Des Moines, Iowa

and to faithfully perform all the terms and requirements of the Contract within the time specified, in a good and workmanlike manner, and in accordance with the Contract Documents. Provided however, that one year after the date of acceptance by the Jurisdiction as complete, of the work under the above referenced Contract, the maintenance portion of this Bond shall continue in force but the penal sum for maintenance shall be reduced to the sum of <a href="Two Hundred Sixty Four Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty Four and 50/100 dollars">Two Hundred Sixty Four Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty Four and 50/100 dollars</a> (\$264,864.50), which is the cost associated with those items shown on the Proposal and in the Contract which require a maintenance bond period in excess of one year.

It is expressly understood and agreed by the Contractor and Surety that the following provisions are a part of this Bond and are binding upon the Contractor and Surety, to-wit:

1. PERFORMANCE: The Contractor shall well and faithfully observe, perform, fulfill and abide by each and every covenant, condition and part of the Contract and Contract Documents, by reference made a part hereof, and shall indemnify and save harmless the Jurisdiction from all outlay and expense incurred by the Jurisdiction by reason of the Contractor's default or failure to perform as required. The Contractor shall also be responsible for the default or failure to perform as required under the Contract and Contract Documents by all its subcontractors, suppliers, agents, or employees furnishing materials or providing labor in the performance of the Contract.

- 2. PAYMENT: The Contractor and Surety on this bond hereby agree to pay all just claims submitted by persons, firms, subcontractors, and corporations furnishing materials for or performing labor in the performance of the Contract, including but not limited to claims for all amounts due for labor, materials, lubricants, oil, gasoline, repairs on machinery, equipment and tools, consumed or used by the Contractor or any subcontractor, wherein the same are not satisfied out of the portion of the contract price which the Jurisdiction is required to retain until completion of the improvement, but the Contractor and Surety shall not be liable unless the claims have been established as provided by law. The Contractor and Surety hereby bind themselves to the obligations and conditions set forth in Iowa Code Chapter 573.
- 3. MAINTENANCE: The Contractor and the Surety shall, at their own expense:
  - A. Remedy any and all defects that may develop in or result from work to be performed under the Contract within the period of <u>four (4)</u> year(s) from the date of acceptance of the work under the Contract, by reason of defects in workmanship or materials used in construction of the work;
  - B. Keep all work in continuous good repair; and
  - C. Pay the Jurisdiction's reasonable costs of monitoring and inspecting to assure that any defects are remedied, and to repay the Jurisdiction all outlay and expense incurred as a result of Contractor's and Surety's failure to remedy any defect as required by this section.

Contractor's and Surety's obligation extends to defects in workmanship or materials not discovered or known to the Jurisdiction at the time the work was accepted.

- 4. GENERAL: Every Surety on this Bond shall be deemed and held bound, any contract to the contrary notwithstanding, to the following provisions:
  - A. To consent without notice to any extension of time to the Contractor in which to perform the Contract;
  - B. To consent without notice to any change in the Contract or Contract Documents, that increases the total contract price and the penal sum of this bond, provided that all such changes do not, in the aggregate, involve an increase of more than twenty percent of the total contract price, and that this Bond shall then be released as to such excess increase; and
  - C. To consent without notice that this Bond shall remain in full force and effect until the contract is completed, whether completed within the specified contract period, within an extension thereof, or within a period of time after the contract period has elapsed and liquidated damages are being charged against the Contractor.
- 5. The Contractor and every Surety on this Bond shall be deemed and held bound, any contract to the contrary notwithstanding, to the following provisions:
  - A. That no provision of this Bond or of any other contract shall be valid which limits to less than five years after the acceptance of the work under the Contract the right to sue on this Bond.

- B. That as used herein, the phrase "all outlay and expense" is not to be limited in any way, but shall include the actual and reasonable costs and expenses incurred by the Jurisdiction including interest, benefits and overhead as applicable. Accordingly, "all outlay and expense" would include but not be limited to all contract or employee expense, all equipment usage or rental, materials, testing, outside experts, attorneys fees (including overhead expenses of the Jurisdiction's staff attorneys), and all costs and expenses of litigation as they are incurred by the Jurisdiction. It is intended the Contractor and Surety will defend and indemnify the Jurisdiction on all claims made against the Jurisdiction on account of Contractor's failure to perform as required in the Contract and Contract Documents, that all agreements and promises set forth in the Contract and Contract Documents, in approved change orders, and in this Bond will be fulfilled, and that the Jurisdiction will be fully indemnified so that it will be put into the position it would have been in had the Contract been performed in the first instance as required.
- C. In the event the Jurisdiction incurs any "outlay and expense" in defending itself with respect to any claim as to which the Contractor or Surety should have provided the defense, or in the enforcement of the promises given by the Contractor in the Contract, Contract Documents, or approved change orders, or in the enforcement of the promises given by the Contractor and Surety in this Bond, the Contractor and Surety agree that they will make the Jurisdiction whole for all such outlay and expense, provided that the Surety's obligation under this Bond shall not exceed 125% of the penal sum of this Bond.

In the event that any actions or proceedings are initiated with respect to this Bond, the parties agree that the venue thereof shall be Polk County, State of Iowa. If legal action is required by the Jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of this Bond or to collect the monetary obligation accruing to the benefit of the Jurisdiction, the Contractor and Surety agree, jointly and severally, to pay the Jurisdiction all outlay and expense incurred by the Jurisdiction. All rights, powers, and remedies of the Jurisdiction hereunder shall be cumulative and not alternative and shall be in addition to all rights, powers and remedies given to the Jurisdiction, by law. The Jurisdiction may proceed against the Surety for any amount guaranteed hereunder whether action is brought against the Contractor or whether or not the Contractor is joined in the action.

NOW THEREFORE, the condition of this obligation is such that if the Principal shall faithfully perform all of the promises of the Principal, as set forth and provided in the Contract, in the Contract Documents, and in this Bond, then this obligation shall be null and void, otherwise it shall remain in full force and effect.



## Nonwaiver of Government Immunity

The purchase of this policy and naming of the organization shown in the Schedule as an additional insured does not waive any of the defenses of governmental immunity available to the organization shown in the Schedule under Code of lowa Section 670.4 as it now exists and as it may be amended from time to time.

## Claims Coverage

This policy shall cover only those claims not subject to the defense of governmental immunity under the Code of Iowa Section 670.4 as it now exists and as it may be amended from time to time.

## **Assertion of Government Immunity**

The organization shown in the Schedule shall be responsible for asserting any defense of governmental immunity, and may do so at any time and shall do so upon the timely written request of the insurance carrier.

## Non-Denial of Coverage for Governmental Immunity

We shall not deny coverage or deny any of the rights and benefits accruing to the organization shown in the Schedule under this policy for reasons of governmental immunity unless and until a court of competent jurisdiction has ruled in Favor of the defense(s) of governmental immunity asserted by the organization shown in the Schedule.

## WAIVER OF OUR RIGHT TO RECOVER FROM OTHERS ENDORSEMENT

We have the right to recover our payments from anyone liable for an injury covered by this policy. We will not enforce our right against the person or organization named in the Schedule. (This agreement applies only to the extent that you perform work under a written contract that requires you to obtain this agreement from us.)

This agreement shall not operate directly or indirectly to benefit anyone not named in the Schedule.

IF YOU ARE REQUIRED BY A WRITTEN CONTRACT OR AGREEMENT, WHICH IS EXECUTED BEFORE A LOSS, TO WAIVE YOUR RIGHTS OF RECOVERY FROM OTHERS, WE AGREE TO WAIVE OUR RIGHT OF RECOVERY.

THIS WAIVER OF RIGHTS APPLIES TO ANY PERSON OR ORGANIZATION FOR WHOM THE NAMED INSURED HAS AGREED BY WRITTEN CONTRACT TO FURNISH THIS WAIVER, BUT SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO BE A WAIVER WITH RESPECT TO ANY OTHER OPERATIONS IN WHICH THE INSURED HAS NO CONTRACTUAL INTEREST.

# CinciPlus® BUSINESS AUTO XC+® (EXPANDED COVERAGE PLUS) ENDORSEMENT

This endorsement modifies insurance provided by the following:

### **BUSINESS AUTO COVERAGE FORM**

With respect to the coverage provided by this endorsement, the provisions of the Coverage Form apply unless modified by this endorsement.

## A. Blanket Waiver of Subrogation

SECTION IV - BUSINESS AUTO CONDITIONS, A. Loss Conditions, 5. Transfer of Rights of Recovery Against Others to Us is amended by the addition of the following:

We walve any right of recovery we may have against any person or organization because of payments we make for "bodily injury" or "property damage" arising out of the operation of a covered "auto" when you have assumed liability for such "bodily injury" or "property damage" under an "insured contract", provided the "bodily injury" or "property damage" occurs subsequent to the execution or the "insured contract".

## B. Noncontributory Insurance

SECTION IV - BUSINESS AUTO CONDITIONS, B. General Conditions, 5. Other Insurance c. is replaced by the following:

Regardless of the provisions of Paragraph a. above, this Coverage Form's Liability Coverage is primary and we will not seek contribution from any other insurance for any liability assumed under an "insured contract" that requires liability to be assumed on a primary noncontributory basis.

## C. Additional Insured by Contract

SECTION II - LIABILITY COVERAGE, A. Coverage, I. Who is an Insured is amended to include as an insured any person or organization with which you have agreed in a valid written contract to provide insurance as is afforded by this policy.

This provision is limited to the scope of the valid written contract.

This provision does not apply unless the valid written contract has been:

- Executed prior to the accident causing "bodily injury" or "property damage"; and
- Is still in force at the time of the "accident" causing "bodily injury" or "property damage".

## D. Employee Hired Auto

## 1. Changes in Liability Coverage

The following is added to the Section II -Liability Coverage, A. Coverage, 1. Who is an Insured:

An "employee" of yours is an "insured" while operating an "auto" hired or rented under a contract or agreement in that "employee's" name, with your permission, while performing duties related to the conduct of your business.

## 2. Changes in General Conditions

SECTION IV - BUSINESS AUTO CON-DITIONS, B. General Conditions, 5. Other Insurance is amended by replacing Paragraph 5.b. with the following:

- For Hired Auto Physical Damage Coverage the following are deemed to be covered "autos" you own:
  - (1) Any covered "auto" you lease, hire, rent or borrow; and
  - (2) Any covered "auto" hired or rented by your "employee" under a contract in that individual "employee's" name, with your permission, while performing duties related to the conduct of your business.

However, any "auto" that is leased, hired, rented or borrowed with a driver is not a covered "auto".

## E. Audio, Visual and Data Electronic Equipment

SECTION III - PHYSICAL DAMAGE COV-ERAGE, C. Limit of Insurance is amended by adding the following:

- 4. The most we will pay for all "loss" to audio, visual or data electronic equipment and any accessories used with this equipment as a result of any one "accident" is the lesser of:
  - The actual cash value of the damaged or stolen property as of the time of the "accident";
  - The cost of repairing or replacing the damaged or stolen property with other property of like kind and quality; or
  - c. \$2,500.

Provided the equipment, at the time of the "loss" is:

- a. Permanently installed in or upon the covered "auto" in a housing, opening or other location that is not normally used by the "auto" manufacturer for the installation of such equipment;
- Removable from a permanently installed housing unit as described in Paragraph 2.a. above; or
- c. An integral part of such equipment.

### F. Who is an Insured - Amended

SECTION II - LIABILITY COVERAGE, A. Coverage, 1. Who is an Insured is amended by adding the following:

The following are "insureds":

Any subsidiary which is a legally incorporated entity of which you own a financial interest of more than 50% of the voting stock on the effective date of this coverage form.

However, the insurance afforded by this provision does not apply to any subsidiary that is an "insured" under any other automobile liability policy, or would be an "insured" under such policy but for termination of such policy or the exhaustion of such policy's limits of insurance.

2. Any organization that is newly acquired or formed by you and over which you maintain majority ownership. The insurance provided by this provision:

- a. Is effective on the date of acquisition or formation, and is afforded for 180 days after such date;
- b. Does not apply to "bodily injury" or "property damage" resulting from an "accident" that occurred before you acquired or formed the organization;
- Does not apply to any newly acquired or formed organization that is a joint venture or partnership; and
- d. Does not apply to an insured under any other automobile liability policy, or would be an insured under such a policy but for the termination of such policy or the exhaustion of such policy's limits of insurance.
- Any of your "employees" while using a covered "auto" in your business or your personal affairs, provided you do not own, hire or borrow that "auto".
- G. Liability Coverage Extensions Supplementary Payments Higher Limits

SECTION II - LIABILITY COVERAGE, A. Coverage, 2. Coverage Extensions, a. Supplementary Payments is amended by:

- Replacing the \$2,000 Limit of Insurance for bail bonds with \$4,000 in (2); and
- Replacing the \$250 Limit of Insurance for reasonable expenses with \$500 in (4).

## H. Amended Fellow Employee Exclusion

SECTION II - LIABILITY COVERAGE, B. Exclusions, 5. Fellow Employee is modified as follows:

Exclusion 5. Fellow Employee is deleted.

## l. Hired Auto - Physical Damage

If hired "autos" are covered "autos" for Liability Coverage, then Comprehensive and Collision Physical Damage Coverages as provided under SECTION III - PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE of this Coverage Part are extended to "autos" you hire, subject to the following:

- The most we will pay for "loss" to any hired "auto" is \$50,000 or the actual cash value or cost to repair or replace, whichever is the least, minus a deductible.
- The deductible will be equal to the largest deductible applicable to any owned "auto" for that coverage, or \$1,000, whichever is less.
- Hired Auto Physical Damage coverage is excess over any other collectible insurance

4. Subject to the above limit, deductible, and excess provisions we will provide coverage equal to the broadest coverage applicable to any covered "auto" you own insured under this policy.

Coverage includes loss of use of that hired auto, provided it results from an "accident" for which you are legally liable and as a result of which a monetary loss is sustained by the leasing or rental concern. The most we will pay for any one "accident" is \$3,000.

If a limit for Hired Auto - Physical Damage is shown in the Schedule, then that limit replaces, and is not added to, the \$50,000 limit indicated above.

## J. Rental Reimbursement

**SECTION III - PHYSICAL DAMAGE** is amended by adding the following:

- 1. We will pay for rental reimbursement expenses incurred by you for the rental of an "auto" because of a "loss" to a covered "auto". Payment applies in addition to the otherwise applicable amount of each coverage you have on a covered "auto". No deductible applies to this coverage.
- We will pay only for those expenses incurred during the policy period beginning 24 hours after the "loss" and ending, regardless of the policy's expiration, with the lesser of the following number of days:
  - a. The number of days reasonably required to repair the covered "auto". If "loss" Is caused by theft, this number of days is added to the number of days it takes to locate the covered "auto" and return it to you; or
  - b. 30 days.
- Our payment is limited to the lesser of the following amounts:
  - Necessary and actual expenses incurred; or
  - **b.** \$50 per day.
- 4. This coverage does not apply while there are spare or reserve "autos" available to you for your operations.
- We will pay under this coverage only that amount of your rental reimbursement expenses which is not already provided for under SECTION III - PHYSICAL DAM-AGE COVERAGE, A. Coverage, 4. Coverage Extensions.

K. Transportation Expense - Higher Limits

SECTION III - PHYSICAL DAMAGE COV-ERAGE, A. Coverage, 4. Coverage Extensions is amended by replacing \$20 per day with \$50 per day, and \$600 maximum with \$1,500 maximum in Extension a. Transportation Expenses.

## L. Airbag Coverage

SECTION III - PHYSICAL DAMAGE COV-ERAGE, B. Exclusions, 3.a. is amended by adding the following:

However, the mechanical and electrical breakdown portion of this exclusion does not apply to the accidental discharge of an airbag. This coverage for airbags is excess over any other collectible insurance or warranty.

## M. Loan or Lease Gap Coverage

- SECTION III PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE, C. Limit of Insurance is deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following, but only for private passenger type "autos" with an original loan or lease, and only in the event of a "total loss" to such a private passenger type "auto";
  - a. The most we will pay for "loss" in any one "accident" is the greater of:
    - (1) The amount due under the terms of the lease or loan to which your covered private passenger type "auto" is subject, but will not include:
      - (a) Overdue lease or loan payments:
      - (b) Financial penalties imposed under the lease due to high mileage, excessive use or abnormal wear and tear;
      - (c) Security deposits not refunded by the lessor;
      - (d) Costs for extended warranties, Credit Life Insurance, Health, Accident or Disability Insurance purchased with the loan or lease; and
      - (e) Carry-over balances from previous loans or leases, or
    - (2) Actual cash value of the stolen or damaged property.
  - b. An adjustment for depreciation and physical condition will be made in determining actual cash value at the time of "loss".

 SECTION V - DEFINITIONS is amended by adding the following, but only for the purposes of this Loan or Lease Gap Coverage:

"Total loss" means a "loss" in which the cost of repairs plus the salvage value exceeds the actual cash value.

N. Glass Repair - Waiver of Deductible

SECTION III - PHYSICAL DAMAGE COV-ERAGE, D. Deductible is amended by adding the following:

No deductible applies to glass damage if the glass is repaired in a manner acceptable to us rather than replaced.

O. Duties in the Event of an Accident, Claim, Suit or Loss - Amended

SECTION IV - BUSINESS AUTO CONDITIONS, A. Loss Conditions, 2. Duties in the Event of Accident, Claim, Suit or Loss, a. is amended by adding the following:

This condition applies only when the "accident" or "loss" is known to:

- 1. You, if you are an individual;
- 2. A partner, if you are a partnership;
- An executive officer or insurance manager, if you are a corporation; or
- A member or manager, if you are a limited liability company.

P. Unintentional Failure to Disclose Hazards

SECTION IV - BUSINESS AUTO CONDITIONS, B. General Conditions, 2. Concealment, Misrepresentation or Fraud is amended by adding the following:

However, if you unintentionally fall to disclose any hazards existing on the effective date of this Coverage Form, we will not deny coverage under this Coverage Form because of such failure.

Q. Mental Anguish Resulting from Bodily Injury

SECTION V - DEFINITIONS, C. "Bodily injury" is deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

"Bodily injury" means bodily injury, sickness or disease sustained by a person, including mental anguish and death sustained by the same person that results from such bodily injury, sickness or disease. "Bodily injury" does not include mental anguish or death that does not result from bodily injury, sickness or disease.

R. Coverage for Certain Operations in Connection with Railroads

With respect to the use of a covered "auto" in operations for or affecting a railroad:

- Section V Definitions, H. "Insured contract", 1.c. is amended to read;
  - An easement or license agreement;
- Section V Definitions, H. "Insured contract", 2.a. is deleted.
