APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT VEHICLE FOR USE IN PUBLIC SAFETY

WHEREAS, the Fleet Division has requested the Finance Department's Procurement Division issue a purchase order for the purchase of a Replacement Vehicle for use in Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, the Replacement Vehicle is being procured through the competitive bid process using the HGACBuy contract number AM10-20; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726 (m) provides for the procurement of goods and/or services from contracts that have been competitively established through cooperative group contracting consortiums for state government departments, institutions, agencies and political subdivisions, without conforming to the competitive bidding requirements of the Procurement Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Replacement Vehicle is being purchased from LDV Custom Specialty Vehicles, 180 Industrial Drive, Burlington WI, 51305, (Kurt Petrie, President) in the amount of \$209,153.00 utilizing the HGACBuy contract number AM10-20; and

WHEREAS, funding is available from HSP00219 544070 Iowa Department of Homeland Security Grant fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, approves the purchase of a Replacement Vehicle for use in Public Safety from LDV Custom Specialty Vehicles in the total amount of \$209,153.00 using the HGACBuy contract number AM10-20.
