ABATEMENT OF PUBLIC NUISANCES AT 3606 47TH ST.

WHEREAS, the property located at 3606 47th St., Des Moines, Iowa, was inspected by representatives of the City of Des Moines who determined that the main structure and accessory structure in their present condition constitute not only a menace to health and safety but are also public nuisances; and

WHEREAS, the Titleholders, Stephen R. Wicks and Dana D. Wicks, were notified more than thirty days ago to repair or demolish the main structure and accessory structure and as of this date have failed to abate the nuisances.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA:

The main structure and accessory structure on the real estate legally described as the North 1/2 of Lot 27 (except the West 90 feet thereof) in J.N. CASADY'S Official Plat, now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa, and locally known as 3606 47th St., have previously been declared public nuisances;

The City Legal Department is hereby authorized to file an action in district court to obtain a decree ordering the abatement of the public nuisances, and should the owner(s) fail to abate the nuisances, as ordered, that the matter may be referred to the Department of Engineering which will take all necessary action to demolish and remove said structures.
