WHEREAS, Article III, Division 1, at section 60-200 of Chapter 60 of the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines provides for fees to photographs pertaining to public nuisances; and

WHEREAS, Article II, at section 86(k) of Chapter 86 of the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines provides for fees related to administrative expenses; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Schedule of Fees to align with Iowa Code Chapter 22 has been prepared for Council consideration and is recommended for adoption, which amendment is appended hereto and is now on file in the office of the City Clerk;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa that the amendment to the Schedule of Fees appended hereto is hereby approved and adopted;
