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HOLD HEARING FOR VACATION OF EXCESS EAST-WEST ALLEY RIGHT-OF-WAY LOCATED SOUTH OF EAST RAILROAD AVENUE, NORTH OF HARRIET STREET AND EAST OF SOUTHEAST 15TH STREET

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2022, by Roll Call No. 22-1137 the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa voted to receive and file a recommendation from the City Plan and Zoning Commission to approve a request from the City Engineer to vacate an undeveloped east/west alley right-of-way in the vicinity of SE 15th Street and E. Railroad Avenue to allow assembly of parcels for the City of Des Moines' solar field, subject to the reservation of easements for all existing utilities in place until such time as they are abandoned or relocated; and

WHEREAS, there is no known current or future public need or benefit for the right-of-way proposed to be vacated and the City will not be inconvenienced by the vacation of said right-of-way, subject to the reservation of any necessary easements for all existing utilities in place until such time as they may be abandoned or relocated; and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2022, by Roll Call No. 22-1140, it was duly resolved by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the proposed vacation of the right-of-way be set for hearing on August 8, 2022 at 5:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa; and

WHEREAS, due notice of said proposal to vacate the east-west alley right-of-way located south of East Railroad Avenue, north of Harriet Street and east of Southeast 15th Street, was given to all necessary parties as provided by law, setting forth the time and place for hearing on said proposal; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with City Council direction, those interested in the proposed vacation, both for and against, have been given an opportunity to be heard with respect thereto and have presented their views to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

- 1. Upon due consideration of the facts and statements of interested persons, any and all objections to the proposed vacation of the east-west alley right-of-way located south of East Railroad Avenue, north of Harriet Street and east of Southeast 15th Street, as described herein, are hereby overruled and the hearing is closed.
- 2. There is no public need or benefit for the right-of-way proposed to be vacated, and the public would not be inconvenienced by reason of the vacation of said right-of-way, legally described as follows, and said vacation is hereby approved, subject to the reservation of any necessary easements for all existing utilities in place until such time as they may be abandoned or relocated:
