WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines has been awarded the 2022 Supporting Law Enforcement Agencies in Seeking Accreditation grant award through the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Office in the amount of \$239,677.25 with no match requirement; and

WHEREAS, the grant performance period began September 1, 2022, and will continue through August 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the funding will be used in support of accreditation for law enforcement, emergency dispatch and the police academy; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the 2022 Supporting Law Enforcement Agencies in Seeking Accreditation grant award through the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Office is hereby approved, with the Mayor authorized to sign the award documentation on behalf of the City, with the City Clerk to attest to the Mayor's signature, and the City Manager or his designee is directed to take any and all steps necessary to timely file and implement the grant award document.
