APPROVAL OF 2023-2024 EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT (ESG) FUNDING UNDER THE US DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD)

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines receives annual Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) entitlement funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, HUD has notified the City that its 2023 ESG allocation is \$336,226; and

WHEREAS, in May 2023 the City of Des Moines and Homeward, the local Continuum of Care, issued a notice of funding availability requesting proposals for use of the 2023 and 2024 ESG funds and received eight (8) proposals, which were reviewed by City staff and the Homeward Grant Committee; and

WHEREAS, City staff and the Homeward Grant Committee recommend allocating the funding according to the accompanying Council Communication as follows:
