## APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AN UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (USDOT) SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) IMPLEMENTATION GRANT

WHEREAS, the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, 2021, established the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) discretionary program with \$5 billion in appropriated funds over 5 years; and

WHEREAS, the funds for the SS4A Program are to be awarded on a competitive basis for regional, local, and Tribal initiatives through grants to prevent roadway deaths and serious injuries; and


WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines has conducted detailed analyses of traffic crashes reported in the years from 2017 to 2021 to identify street corridors on the High Interval Network (HIN) that have high levels of fatal and severe injury crashes and developed a Transportation Safety Action Plan that subscribes to principles and approaches with the objective to reduce fatal and severe injuries in the City to zero by 2040, which satisfies many of the selection criteria for an implementation grant and aligns well with the SS4A's priorities on several points; and

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines Engineering Department is preparing a grant application to implement safety related improvements identified on the City's High Injury Network with the following street projects:

- (1) Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway & 19th Street from Cottage Grove Avenue to Washington Avenue,
- (2) Douglas Avenue (U.S. 6) from Merle Hay Road to Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway,
- (3) Euclid Avenue (U.S. 6) from Des Moines River to 2nd Avenue,
- (4) Forest Avenue from Beaver Avenue to 9th Street,
- (5) SE 14th Street (U.S. 69) from Des Moines River to Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway; and

WHEREAS, total project costs are estimated to be \$27 million, with the SS4A Grant amount of \$17 million; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer recommends that the City Council authorize the implementation grant application for SS4A discretionary program.
