## HOLD HEARING FOR APPROVAL OF DOCUMENTS FOR CONVEYANCE OF EXCESS CITY PROPERTY LOCALLY KNOWN AS 4030 53<sup>RD</sup> STREET, DES MOINES, IOWA TO BARRY POTTINGER FOR \$500.00

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2018, by Roll Call No. 18-1218, the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa voted to authorize the City Manager to develop and implement an administrative plan for the voluntary acquisition of certain one and two-family residential flood damaged properties; and

WHEREAS, by the end of December 2018, the City of Des Moines had acquired a total of seventy-seven (77) properties from those owners who had chosen to participate in the buyout program, with the demolition and removal of all structures being completed by May of 2019; and

WHEREAS, it was subsequently determined by City Engineering, Public Works, and Community Development staff that eighteen (18) of the acquired properties, all of which are located outside of the Fourmile Creek area, including the parcel at 4030 53<sup>rd</sup> Street, could be sold to adjoining property owners for use as expanded sideyard only, subject to a reservation of easements therein, and further subject to the reservation of a Permanent Easement for Storm Sewer and Surface Water Flowage which will be included in the Quit Claim Deed from City to the buyer; and

**WHEREAS**, Barry Pottinger has offered to the City of Des Moines, Iowa ("City") the purchase price of \$500.00 for the purchase of 4030 53<sup>rd</sup> Street (hereinafter "Property") for sideyard purposes only, subject to a reservation of easements therein, and further subject to the reservation of a Permanent Easement for Storm Sewer and Surface Water Flowage, which price reflects the fair market value of the City Property as determined by the City's Real Estate Division; and

WHEREAS, there is no known current or future public need for the City Property proposed to be sold, and the City will not be inconvenienced by the sale of said Property.

WHEREAS, on July 17, by Roll Call No. <u>23-0992</u>, it was duly resolved by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the proposed conveyance of the excess City-owned property be set for hearing on August 7, 2023, at 5:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa; and

WHEREAS, due notice of said proposal to convey the City Property was given to all necessary parties as provided by law, setting forth the time and place for hearing on said proposal; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with City Council direction, those interested in the proposed vacation and conveyance, both for and against, have been given an opportunity to be heard with respect thereto and have presented their views to the City Council.

- 7. Upon receipt of the recorded documents back from the Polk County Recorder, the Real Estate Division Manager shall mail the original of the Quit Claim Deed and a copy of the other documents to the grantee.
