HEARING ON BIRDLAND AND ASHWORTH POOL BUILDING REPAIRS REJECT ALL BIDS, AND CLOSE THE HEARING ON THE PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, FORM OF CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, AND ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE

WHEREAS, on October 07, 2024, under Roll Call No. October 07, 2024, plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost were filed with the City Clerk, for the construction of the following improvement:

Birdland and Ashworth Pool Building Repairs, Activity ID 112024013

The improvement includes the demolition of existing lighting, removal of mortar joints and glazed faces of concrete block, new lighting, repointing of mortar joints throughout, painting, and an add-alternate to construct a shade structure, all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File No. 665-001/018, located at Birdland Pool Facility, 300 Holcomb Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa and at Ashworth Pool Facility, 102 45th Street, Des Moines, Iowa

WHEREAS, notice of the hearing on the plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost was published as required by law.


WHEREAS, the Des Moines City Engineer, as the Engineer, and the Parks and Recreation Director recommend rejection of all bids because there were only two (2) bids submitted and the apparent low bid was submitted by Bi-State Masonry, Inc., Chris Belser, President, 3511 8th Street, Rock Island, IL 61201, in the amount of \$317,776 for the base bid, which is 16.4% or \$44,776 over the Engineer's base bid estimate of \$273,000. Engineering and Parks Department staff have reviewed the bids and recommend reevaluating the scope of the project for possible rebidding in the future.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That the hearing on the plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost for said improvement be and is hereby **CLOSED**.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

which were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on October 22, 2024. Said bids and the attached tabulation of bids for said improvement be and are hereby received, and filed.
