RESOLUTION APPROVING 2 TAX ABATEMENT APPLICATIONS FOR WORK COMPLETED IN IN 2023

WHEREAS, the Iowa Urban Revitalization Act, Chapter 404, Code of Iowa (the "Act"), provides for partial exemption from property tax for the actual value added by improvements to property located in a designated urban revitalization area which are consistent with the urban revitalization plan for such area; and,

WHEREAS, the Act provides that persons making improvements may apply to the City Council for tax abatement, and the City Council shall approve the application by resolution, subject to review by the County Assessor, if it finds: (a) the project is in a designated urban revitalization area; (b) the project is in conformance with the urban revitalization plan for such area; and (c) the improvements were made during the time the area was so designated; and,

WHEREAS, the City-wide Urban Revitalization Plan provides that to qualify for tax exemption eligibility, the improvements must be completed in accordance with all applicable zoning and other regulations of the City; and,

WHEREAS, 2 untimely applications for tax abatement has been received for qualifying improvements completed after December 31, 2022, which is now on file and available for inspection by the public in the office of the City Clerk; and,

WHEREAS, the applications have been reviewed and are now recommended for approval by City staff as further described in the accompanying Council Communication.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:

- 1. Each application for tax abatement is hereby received.
- 2. The following findings are hereby adopted with respect to each application:
 - a. The applications are for improvements completed in 2023.
 - b. The application was not timely filed by the February 1, 2024 deadline to be applied to the value added during 2023. Because the application was filed after the deadline, but within the 2-year grace period allowed by Iowa Code, City staff recommends that City Council approve the late filing of the application by this resolution and recommends approval of the application itself, subject to review by the county assessor.
 - c. The City Council finds that:
 - i. The project is located in a designated urban revitalization area;
 - ii. The improvements were made during the time the area was so designated;
