**PUBLIC HEARING, APPROVING PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS,
FORM OF CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, AND ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE ON
2026 HMA RESIDENTIAL PAVING PROGRAM; RECEIVE AND FILE BIDS;
AND DESIGNATION OF LOWEST RESPONSIVE, RESPONSIBLE BIDDER AS
INROADS, LLC, JOSEPH J. MANATT, CEO, \$994,415**

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2026, under Roll Call No. 26-0284, plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost were filed with the City Clerk, for the construction of the following public improvement:

2026 HMA Residential Paving Program, Activity ID 062026003

The improvement includes furnishing labor, equipment, and materials for the removal of existing Hot-Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement and surfacing materials by milling/scarifying to average depths of two (2) inches or four (4) inches, prepare subgrade/subbase, pave streets with two (2) inches of HMA pavement in one (1) lift or four (4) inches of HMA pavement with two (2) lifts, replace sections of Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) curb and gutter, and replace existing sidewalk ramps with ADA-compliant ramps, all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations and other locations as directed by the City Engineer in Des Moines, Iowa:

1. Olive Avenue from 19th Street to 17th Street
2. Columbia Street from Euclid Avenue to E Madison Avenue
3. SE 25th Street from Maury Street to Shaw Street
4. Shaw Street from SE 25th Street to dead end east
5. E 27th Street from E Douglas Avenue to E Madison Avenue
6. E Ovid Avenue from Oxford Street to Cambridge Street
7. E Ovid Street from Cambridge Street to Cornell Street
8. Taylor Street from Indianola Road to Holmes Street; and

WHEREAS, notice of the hearing on the plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost was published as required by law; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with said notice, those interested in said proposed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost, both for and against, have been given opportunity to be heard with respect thereto and have presented their views to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That upon due consideration of the facts, and any and all statements of interested persons, any objections to the plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost for said public improvement are overruled and the hearing is closed, and that plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of construction cost are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That sealed bids for said public improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

- InRoads, LLC, Des Moines, IA - Low Bid
- Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Des Moines, IA
- OMG Midwest, Inc. dba Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Ankeny, IA

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the bid security of the unsuccessful bidders be and is hereby authorized and directed to be returned in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Engineer is hereby directed to secure execution by the lowest responsible, responsive Bidder and its surety of the contract documents in the form heretofore approved by this Council; that the Engineer is directed to thereafter present said contract documents to this Council for approval and authorization to the Mayor to sign; and that no contract shall be deemed to exist between the City of Des Moines and said Bidder until said contract has been executed by the Bidder, and shall have been approved by this Council and executed by the Mayor and attested to by the City Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the necessary closure of all public grounds, streets, sidewalks, alleys, bridges, culverts, overpasses, underpasses, grade crossing separations and approaches, public ways, squares, and commons for the Project.
